Just look at the length of the hand saw they needed...



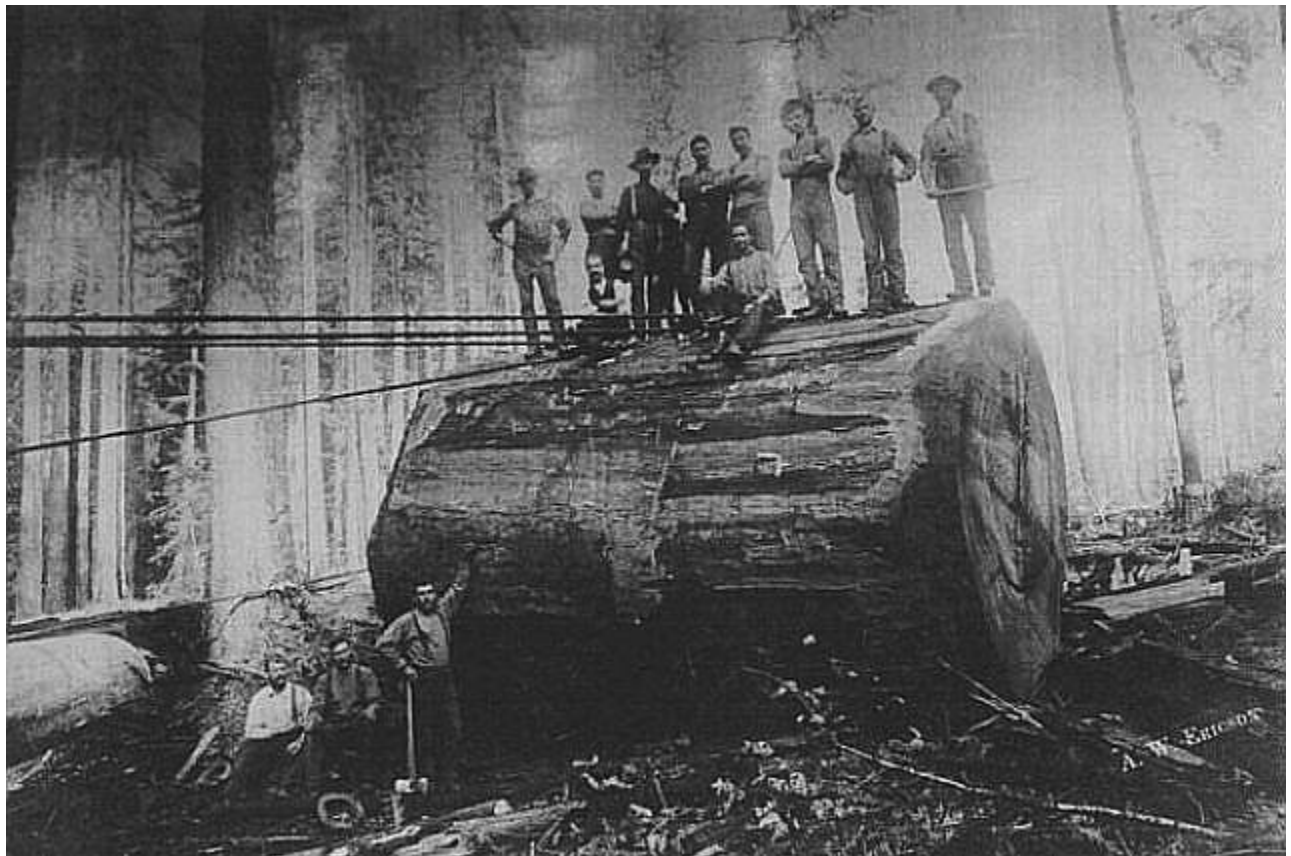
...and look at the size of the heavy duty axes...
