

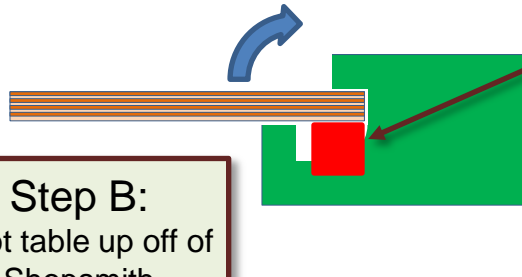
Custom table

Engaging Custom Table in wooden "hands" to hoist it off of Shopsmith (Reverse steps to re-mount table)

Step A:

- Raise table to most frequently-used thin-stock height.
- Roll Shopsmith back so outfeed edge engages wooden hands mounted to wall (green)
- Note that red knobs (2) are in front of front hand and behind rear hand in this view. (see next page for front view).

One of 2 wooden "hands" mounted to wall



Step B:

pivot table up off of Shopsmith (using pulleys w/2-to-1 roping arrangement suggested by 'riot_nrrd')

Knobs (2) on outfeed corners of Custom table to keep table from slipping sideways off either hand. (see next page)

Step C:

lift vertical table up off of wooden hands, pull bottom out a few inches to clear wooden hands, and then lower table to floor (using pulleys w/2-to-1 roping)

Step D:

lean table against wall and use Shopsmith without Custom Table for next operation.
